

JAN D. HAIZMANN



Jan Haizmann is a qualified lawyer and graduated in Germany, UK and Belgium.

Dr Haizmann started his career as associate at a German law firm Graf von Westphalen, specializing on European competition law and regulation in the telecoms sector. In 1999, Dr. Haizmann moved to London working as regulatory affairs manager for Enron Europe and subsequently at TXU Europe focusing on industry regulation applicable to the power and gas sector – he was in charge of competition and antitrust matters for the European region.

Since 2005, Mr. Haizmann has been an independent consultant to the energy trading industry, based in Brussels, advising clients on legal and regulatory aspects of energy trading with focus on gas markets. Dr Haizmann has been managing director of Correggio Consulting Limited which he founded as boutique consulting in 2005 - www.correggio-consulting.eu . Correggio Consulting operates through retained staff and a network of experienced experts across Europe.

In parallel to his consulting activities, Mr. Haizmann had different executive industry functions within the European Federation of Energy Traders (EFET). Between 2006 and 2023 Mr Haizmann was member of the EFET Board of Directors, served as Chairman of the EFET Legal Committee, and served as Director of the EFET offices in Berlin and Brussels for several years.

In May 2023, Mr Haizmann assumed the role as DSecretary General of ZETA (Zero Emissions Traders Alliance). ZETA aims at promoting the role of traded markets for countries in the MENA region on their path towards net zero. ZETA is proposing a suitable market framework and transaction tools, including standard contracts, with a view to facilitating climate neutrality in the MENA region and beyond. ZETA offers expertise in the creation of markets and the use of market-based mechanisms to achieve climate neutrality combined with energy security at least cost. ZETA envisages, the current energy markets shall become traded markets in a combination of energy carriers, emission credits, guarantees of origin and sustainability certificates.

Mr Haizmann attended and graduated with honours at the universities in Freiburg (1st State Exam at Law, 2nd State Exam), London (Master of Laws – LL.M.) and Brussels (PhD). He was admitted to the German Bar in 1994. He is fluent in German, English, French at Dutch.
